March 22<sup>nd</sup> Lat 45-5 Long 58-54

Dist 224 Ship rolled very heavily

23<sup>rd</sup> Lat 45-4 Long 64-45 Dist 249

Fine breeze & sun shining very bright

Mon 24<sup>th</sup> Lat 45-48 Long 68-1 Dis 139

very cold & raining, sea rough

Tues 25<sup>th</sup> Lat 45-16 Long 71-47 E

Dist 159 mls wet & cold

Wed 26<sup>th</sup> Lat 46-2 Long 76-30 Dis 205

weather very foggy. Men are busy

cleaning the vessel ready for pointing

Thurs 27<sup>th</sup> Lat 46-51 Long 81-39 Dis 220

The wind blew very hard during the night & poured with rain seas came over & we had the water in our cabin

Frid 28<sup>th</sup> Lat 47-56 S Long 87-21 E

Dis 242 mls Very heavy gale of wind

took nearly all sail in, the sea very rough, things in cabin rolling about

a Cape Hen caught. Vessel rolling bad.

Sat 29<sup>th</sup> Lat 48-14 Long 91-23 Dist 169 mls

No sleep vessel rolling too much.
