a calm, a nasty roll, lots of birds about

Sat 12th - Lat 48-16 Long 157-22 Dis 52 mls

We had a very heavy gale, about

40 ft of bulwarks, carried away

the fore upper topsail & a lot of the

upper sails carried away, both watches

on deck & the Captain all night

at 40° the main royal mast &

staysail were carried away the water

came over in tons & we had 2 ft of

water in our cabin, the saloon was

flooded & they had to bale it out

the anchor slipped over the side &

they had hard work to get it back

all the sheep & his rolling about the deck
