Kitten mending pig trough - &c. 3 100
Load of firewood came -
went to Camp in the afternoon
Cor - bought pair blue blanket
for the Camp - & 1/2 lb. tobacco
from Munnis - preparatory Camp 1 00
- Wednesday 13 Marked out three S.P.R's on the
fence from the Point towards the Carr
yesterday paid for meat at Klee's
12th May 1868 4 56
- Thursday 14 Surveyed three other P.R's adjoining
yesterday's - and chained the end
line of Russells 1224 ac. sec.
- Friday 15 Surveyed part of the four S.P.R's
on the fence up Klee's gully. -
&c.
- Saturday 16 Laid out part of two roads through
Russells long sec. in Klee's gully -
& Rode home in the afternoon 10

- Sunday 17 Straightening up & burning rubbish
behind the garden fence. G. Buchanan
up after his horses. went with
L. Smith & Gay in the afternoon to
look at Fraser's house on the
other side.
