- Tuesday 27 Writing reports for the month - went to Cardalis sale to buy a chaff cutter - got out side by Landstrom - rode up to the house with Mack - who slept there. bought 5 gallons Herring -
- Wednesday 28 Paid Landstrom for a bag of oats 12/ cor 2/6. rode to camp. at the Hakahu. saw old Britton 14 6
- Thursday 29 Doctor & Oliver cutting Coy's line Jack & myself chaining Jack's line & the Doctor's road -
- Friday 30<sup>th</sup> Finished chaining the Doctor's road & cut across Jones' sec. laid out east side of 87 sec -
- Saturday 31 Laid out John Gray's sec. & rode home. Jack rode with me to the Point & went to Howell's. Paid Criddle for 1/2 sheep. 8/6. Paid Hamilton for plastering £ 8-15/- 8 6

- Thurs. 5 Cut proof line across Jones' sec. to Coy's line. also cut last line of Jones' long sec. & set out line from Coy's peg. for width of Jones' last sec.
- Fri 6 Wet all day. Staid in tents
- Sat. 7 Wet morning. Doctor & Oliver cut width of Jones' last sec. had to walk to the Point to catch my horse. rode in with Jones. paid Dick Jones for potatoes 5/- 5 0
- Sun. 8<sup>th</sup> Making kitchen dressed. had a walk with L. Smith & Co. to the Cemetery -
- Mon. 9 Prince of Wales birthday called at Fussell's. paper hanging the papers in the afternoon. Fussell, Mr. Mansfield, Sealey, Gay, & Mr. Barclay & L. Smith called -
- Tuesday 10 Paid Mr. Shaw £ 18-10/- Carpet 18 10 0  
clothes, calico for ceiling £ 6-10/- 6 10 0  
Wood for saddle - 8 0 0  
Kitchen for ball - 1 1 0  
cor 3/- bought hat & shoes at Munro's & rode to camp 3 0
