had been strewed on the deck, round the blacksmiths forge, and  
one tremendous piece of the vessel sent it all rolling to the  
leeward, and one or two credulous individuals were induced  
to believe it had been washed on board from the sea and  
took some handfuls to the captain to apprise him of the
