

Diary Continued

- Feb 10<sup>th</sup> Heat 86° Lat 2-47 - 53 miles  
We spoke to a vessel, but she would not stop to take letters, 2 other sails in sight, rained fast in the evening. I went on deck & had a bath in it
- 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Heat 90° 59 miles, very squally strong lightning, crossed the line
- 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 27-47. Long Lat 2.22° Heat 80°  
rained in the morn. Lots of porpoises in sight & bonnetas & flying fish caught windy, the main sky sail was carried away, a schooner in sight
- 14<sup>th</sup> Lat 5-20. Long 29-37 Heat 83°  
Several whale birds seen 8<sup>th</sup> Valentines day, Had a lark sending Val<sup>s</sup> to each other
- 15<sup>th</sup> Lat 8-52. Long 30. Heat 87° 218 miles, fine breeze, played quoits
- 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> Lat 11-51 Long 31-22. dist. 186 miles  
Heat 80° no wind very hot, a fowl got out & fell overboard.
