

4th Lat 7° sun dis 153 mls 2 Sails
in sight. Carpenter bury condensing
water they can condense 200 gals a
day & consume 1 cwt coal. Molly Hawks
seen (small birds)

5th Lat 36.56 Long 15.21 Dis 201 mls
very windy, fore royal split, raining
fast all day. Plenty of Tee birds,
several Albatrosses seen. Cape Pigeons
& ships ahead.

6th Lat 38-39 Long 10-46 W Dist 240 mls
raining in the morning we are now going
on fine if this wind lasts it will soon take
us there. the sea is rather heavy & comes
over a bit, if you dont look out you get wet
7th Lat 39-36 S Long 5-27 W Dist 253 mls
a school of porpoises about Weather colder
I saw a large sun fish

8th Lat 40-45 Long 31m W Dist 239
Drizzling rain Fine moon light night
9th Lat 42-22 S Long 3-22 E Dist 198 mls
several whale birds, molly hawks & a
sea hawk seen Vessel rolling very heavy

Mon 10th Lat 42-28 Long 7-51 E, Dis 204
A very large whale seen quite close
supposed to be about 40 ft in length
Plenty of porpoises about
Tues 11th Lat 42-16 S Long 12-18 E Dis 187-
a large tree seen floating in the water
very cold, a calm in the afternoon
Wed 12th Lat 43.30 Long 65-18 Dis 132 m
Heat 44° On the night we had a heavy
gale the Mizen top sail try sail split
it was very rough & the ship rolled
very much, it carried some of the sails
away & brought others down, the seas
came over & we had two ft of water in
cabin, did not sleep all night.

Thurs 13th Lat 43.51 Long 20-45 Dis 236
The vessel is still rolling very much
the dog kennel was swimming about the
deck with the dog in it, raining fast
Fri 14th Lat 44-3 Long 25-55 Heat 40°
Dist 223 mls the sea is still very rough
& we can get no rest at night
some sick, shall not be sick at all now
