Friday	4 th	Laid sec. on Wilson's road 3 ½ of 70 acres found a water course near after I had done - it is a 50 acre sec - rode home at night -	
Saturday	5 th	At the office with L. Smith all day replotting sections & roads on rubber sheet. & getting out quantities. Gay laid out 20 acre sec. at the Company's land on the upper world side. Went down the Town with Smith ordered 1/2 ton Coal, bought neck tie - got a bad finger	
Sunday	6 th	Cloudy day, hot Worcester did nothing all day.
