10th Gay ill with his throat. Sent him

out in at night for meat.

Kings road & Mrs. King's workshop.

12 Finished Crisp's road over the down
what home in the morning -

paid for 6 lbs butter Brown 9/- - 910

gave Jack Smith 1/- - 110

Monday

13 Went to church - Christened the
baby Bertha Louise - gave
old Foster 20/- for the job - 100

Mrs. P. sent 5 Mrs. King's in
the afternoon she did it.

but I returned with Foster.

14 Plotting Washdyke all day in
the Office - Gay making my sign
gave Martin - 200

Tuesday 15 Went out to the camp. Researched
Sutherland's sec .70 ac. on the
upper Washdyke also the road
through it -

Wednesday 16 Laid out cross road over the
downs about 1 1/2 miles -

Thursday 17 Started paying three sections on
the Washdyke & part of the road
up the Washdyke above Mortimer.

Friday 18 In the office plotting sec.s. & roads.
got letter from Jas. & Tom. Hay.
acknowledging receipt from me of
£46.8. for Shuttleworth's fencing -
planting out green trees in the
evening.

Saturday 19 The mare rambled away yesterday
in her paddock. had to walk to
work. finished paying sec.s. & the
road through them. & shifted
camp to the Washdyke flat. corner
of Tom Hall's fence - walked home
again at night. Called at Sealey's

Sunday 20 W. S. & W. King & Co. made
a visitation to me & stored dinner
brought back after dark.

Monday 21 At the office all day. plotting road in
Washdyke. Payed sec. to Gay went after the
mare found her on the upper Washdyke
Martin sprained his knee, he came up
to the house at night & I gave him the
sack. Gay visiting his wife in town.
Went with Gay in the evening to old
Bonnie's brought two pigs for £1.19.0
gave Gay 70/- 1190

Tuesday 22 Heard of Gay going home by Panama
next month. buying getting up a team
and for him. Drew £33 out of the Bank
made tracing for transferring my work
to the proper bank. paid off for receipt
stamps. 2/- for postage stamps. Paid
Merritt, Co. on ac £60. bought tie of tobacco
saw one way. told H. L. C. one of a piece of land
near my big hole on the N. Chipping
Co. Paid Old Batter up & the end of Dec. 1000
