pole 101 - exploring -
- Thur. 29 Surveyed continuation of Road  
30 from Pelvis up North Branch

- Fri. 30<sup>th</sup> Surveyed ~~land~~ continuation of  
Capt. Jones' road two miles to  
near Trig pole 101 - & rode home  
in the evening -
- Sat. 2 Went to office & then to town bought
