Saturday 2 continued. Bought some malt shops on Thursday intend trying to brew. - cleaned out the boiler. flue & chimney & emptied the pig sty.

Sunday 3 Paving another piece at the back door -

Mon 4<sup>th</sup> Lighted boiler fire, washing day. Cleaned the wash house - Rode to Beach above the wash by the dyer, met Jack there & surveyed a 20 ac see for Mr. Rhodes. Rode home at night brought a couple of teal with me.

Tue 5<sup>th</sup> Jack carting wood to the new camp. I staid at home got the tiles for the verandah floor yesterday put part of them down to day - paid 7/- for carting them up

Wed 6<sup>th</sup> at office, plotting Rhodes see returned home with Mr. King Dr. Butler very ill

Thurs. 7<sup>th</sup> Rode to camp. men shifted camp yesterday - to Horse paddock valley - surveyed one of Russell's sees -

Fri 8 surveyed another of Russell's sees -

Sat. 9<sup>th</sup> Wet day, could do nothing walked home in the afternoon got properly wet -

Sun. 10<sup>th</sup> Heavy rain all night & all day - Jack & Grant turned up early washed out of the camp. Too wet to do anything but make up fires & clear water courses -

Mon 11 at office checking tracing plotted what I have done & home to dinner afternoon - finished cutting some fences, pitched creek from Nicholls for brewing cleaned boiler ready & boiled fowls food for pig -
