- Fri 22 Surveyed 2 secs ea. 39 ac. in a gully. also a piece of road -
- Sat. 23 Surveyed cross road - + rode home found the stack thatched -
- Sunday 24 Paving in the yard abt. the channel - all day - Very windy -
- Mon. 25 Paid Mr. Elworthy for meat 5 40  
Paid Jacob for verandah tiles 4 00  
at Hastings Office all day plotting roads & secs -  
Paid Waugh for thatching spring grass 1 100
- Tu. 26 Rode to camp in levels front paddock. Strong Southerly wind tried to work at Lewis secs. too blowy. Walked over to Nora paddock gully & measured some check lines

- Fri 29 Rode to camp again + surveyed remainder of Lewis sections
- Sat 30<sup>th</sup> Surveyed three secs. above Lewis's and also continued Driscoll's road abt. a mile Geoffrey at the camp waiting for me rode home with him -
- Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> Wet day could do nothing
