Sunday 24 Went to church with Gruff
Polly & Annie - Sorting &c
in the stable after dinner 6

Mon. 25 At Hurling's office as usual
Finished plotting Island run
on his map - went down
town - bought 15 cwt coals
from Jackson & Gibson

Raukapuka section - 3 4 8
Paid Jackson for timber for
weatherboarding side of house 4 12 0
Jack returns from Howells

Tu. 26 Borrowed £5 from Jack
Smith - Carried all maps &c
out of Hurling's office - & went
on board the S.S. Maori in
the evening with Annie
paid passage & boat - 3 5 0

Wed 27 Called at Akaroa abt 9 o'clock
this morning - got in by 11 o'clock
abt 1/2 past 2. landed at
Percy's Wharf. cor 3/6 3 6
Went across to Charteris Bay
in Mr. Bradley's boat
Saw old Wilkin

Thurs 28 Wet miserable day S.E.
Weather walked down in
the afternoon & saw Constable
Gave Mr. Bradley cheque for
cor. his for £5 0/0 4 0 0

my outgoing tenant & agreed
to let the place to Jno Tulloch
for £25 per ann -

Constable gave me his bill
for fencing & improvements
which he made & balance
his rent for 18 months
the amount was £46. 6. 6

Fri 29th Crossed the bay in Tulloch's
boat & Lyttelton went by train
thro. the tunnel for the first
time to Ch. Ch. went to Collins
Hotel & thence to the Survey
Office. Saw Davis, Williams
& E. Sealey. took Annie to
Davis's house - got Crown
Grant for sec. no 226 Timaru
got down. ~~got~~ left conveyance
& thence to occupy for Raukapuka
sec. & conveyance of 2 ac
from Fisher - in the Registration
Office, with authority, with
Jno Williams to receive same
when registered. spent evening
at Davis's & slept at Collins.

Lunch 14/- Crown Grant 24/- 1 4 0
