Monday 1st Arrived off Timaru abt.
breakfast time - heavy
swif running signal'd
to land passengers in life boat
for 20/- each. Declined, on
acc of little Annie. waited
for orders from Dunedin &
then sailed ~~there~~ abt.
2 P.M. arrived inside the
~~harbour~~ spent the evening
playing whist - Cor - - 30

Tu. 2 Arrived inside the heads of
Dunedin bay abt 2 a.m.
anchored & waited for daylight
got up to the Wharf by breakfast
time - went on shore & telegraphed
to Mr. Shaw. called on the Chief
Surveyor Mr. Thompson - took
Annie to see the town dinner 26
got £5 for a cheque from
the mate Mr. Sinclair got
a doll for Ketur & Nellie 4/- 40
