taken possession of the boats on
which we spend most of our
day reading. It is a beautiful
day very calm and bright quite
the reverse of yesterday

10th May 1864 Tuesday

Captⁿ told us this morning that
if he could not get a good
paying cargo from ~~the~~ New Zealand
he would go on to China and
bring home tea - This ship does
not belong to the White Star
line, but is a China tea clipper
and is chartered for this trip
by the White Star line
