Day dark; going about 9 knots;
course, S. E. and by E.

1 sheep and 1 pig killed.

Prisoners as usual.

We all collect for a smoke under
the weather sheet on the poop,
as it is rather cold for Inuits, we
spend most of the day in the cabin.

23rd July 1864 SaturdayLat^{de} 45Long^{de} 19.30

went 200 miles since 12 yesterday

Day damp with occasional sun
shines.

Had the usual glee union
meeting in our cabin as it came
to our turn, The steward supplied
coffee and soda cake we supplied
(J. E. Mac v J) two bottles wine.
