## REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS.

## Births.

By an Act passed in 1874, it is enacted that parents must register every birth, within 42 days of the date thereof, at the Registrar's Office for the District in which they reside. In default, the Registrar is at his Office, and to charge extra fees.

## Deaths.

Deaths must be registered within five days, unless a notice, with medical certiThe nearest relatives of the Registrar. present at death, are liable to penalty for neglect of this regulation.

## MARRIAGE LICENCES.
