A YACHTSMAN'S DODGE. The illustration shows a method that is often practised by yachtsmen. When the tide is running in an opposite direction to that in which the wind is blowing the small boat that is usually fastened to a gentleman's yacht beats against the yacht's side. This is because whilst the yacht lying deep in the water flows with the current the boat is floating on the surface and goes the way of the wind. To stop this beating, the yachtsman throws a bucket attached to the boat into the water.
