PREVENTS SLIPPING. Sometimes when cutting a piece of wood the knife one is using slips, and the blade closing deals one a nasty cut, especially if the blade spring be a strong one. Some knives have safeguards of various forms to guard against this slipping nuisance. That of the usual hunting knife is, perhaps, as simple as any.
