**KEEPS THE TONGUE IN PLACE.** When one's stocking or sock crumples up under the boot from being slightly too large, it creates a very unpleasant feeling. Similarly, when the tongue of one's boot persists in straying to the right or left, and doubles itself up, it becomes a source of great discomfort. To ensure it always being in its place, cut a small hole near the top and put one end of the lace through this before inserting it in the top lace-hole, in the manner shown in the diagram. If this is done the tongue cannot shift from its position.
