**Workers' Commutation Tickets.**—Twelve-trip tickets for distances not over 25 miles, are sold only to persons resident in the neighbourhood of the issuing station. Available only for the purchaser for a fortnight from date of issue.

**School Boarders' Tickets.**—Available for return for two months from date of issue, will be issued, at three-fourths of the ordinary return fare, to school-boarders returning home for holidays at the end of recognised school-terms only.

**School Season Tickets.**—For 3 months.—Not exceeding 16 years, First-class, 30s., Second-class, 20s.; not exceeding 20 years, First-class, 40s., Second-class, 20s. For Students over 20 years of age half ordinary 3-monthly season tickets. *Bona fide* certificate from schoolmaster to be produced.

**Free School Season Tickets.**—Second-class Quarterly to children under 19 attending Government or private primary schools. Available for distances up to 60 miles.

**Excursion Trains** will be run upon payment of a deposit (as a guarantee, returnable if the takings exceed the amount) equivalent to the charge for 80 Second-class Return Tickets. Minimum charge, £5.

In addition to the above rates a charge of 3d. for each cwt. or part of a cwt. will be made upon all parcels consigned to Auckland, Wellington, Te Aro, Christchurch, Dunedin, or Invercargill.

Parcels left at Cloak Room, not exceeding 56lb., first day 2d. every additional day 1d.

**Bicycles.**—Ordinary, complete, not packed in cases or crates, seated to carry one rider, as for 28lb., rate and a quarter.

**Horses and Carriages.**—Any distance not exceeding 10 miles, single horse, 8s. 8d., each additional horse to same owner, 10 miles, single horse 3d.; each additional horse to same owner, 2d.; each two-wheeled carriage, 3d.; ditto four-wheel, 4d.

**Dogs.**—Every fraction of, or 25 miles, per head, 6d.; maximum per head, 5s. All dogs to be provided with chains.

Calves, sheep, goats, pigs, rabbits and poultry, properly secured in baskets, &c., at parcel rates.

**Milk.**—For distances of not more than 11 miles, 2d. per gallon; not more than 21 miles, 3d. per gallon; not more than 31 miles, 4d. per gallon; for every additional 30 miles or fraction thereof over 31 miles, 2d. per gallon.

## STAMP DUTIES.

**Agreement or Memorandum of an Agreement** other than agreement for a lease or by deed—(1) Where the matter thereof is of the value of £20 or upwards, whether the same is only evidence of a contract or obligatory on the parties from its being a written instrument, including every schedule receipt or other matter put or endorsed thereon or annexed thereto, or (2) Where divers letters are offered in evidence to prove any agreement between the writers thereof it shall be sufficient if any one of such letters is stamped with the duty of 2s. 6d.

**Appointment** in execution of a power over any property, or of any use, share, or interest therein by any instrument not being a will, 10s.
