The D.E. was off here and was dropping her shells into a village. The men could see the havoc they were making and were itching to get to it.

27 Sat 86-279

They did not land

in the place intended as the Navy made some mistake and landed them about half a mile further up. They were under a severe indirect shrapnel fire from some warships over in the straits but nevertheless they were very cool and jumped ashore easily. The units and brigades had become mixed before landing but despite the confusion caused thereby and the loss of their officers by snipers they went forward up the hill throwing off their haversacks and knapsacks and rushing forward but this lay out, except any officer who happened to be near
