and we went on and  
arrived in the firing  
line trenches without  
any more casualties  
and managed to dig  
some shells before  
morning. Monday was  
comparatively quiet, three  
men only being hit, one  
was shot clean through  
the brain, it was pro-  
truding at the end, and  
he lay about 20 of an  
hour. There must have  
been some disordered fancy  
in his brain as he was  
wrestling till he died.  
Tuesday was comparatively  
quiet without casualties  
and in the night we were  
relieved by 15<sup>th</sup> Manchester  
who were "green" besides  
being young. They got  
into the trench in the
