There was a heavy fire and we had to burn out and were moved out behind the left which part of the firing line was formed by the N.Z. Brigade. N.Z.M.F. When the firing started I was over in the mountain trenches to see the boys and the men were almost afraid to move off when I got back ~~and~~ up our gully to the bivouac. We slept in the scrub behind the men in expectation of an attack along the beach which however did not eventuate.
