


SEA VETERAN ENDS HER CAREER



THE 45,000-TON AQUITANIA, the grand old lady of the Cunard fleet, which has finished her sea career and will be withdrawn immediately from active service. She may be broken up. Since the Aquitania sailed on her maiden voyage in 1914, she has sailed nearly 3,000,000 miles, and has carried 1,200,000 passengers. She was to have been retired in 1940, but she served throughout the war as a trooper.

Aquitania reached Port Tewfik (Suez) on Sunday, 19 October.
