

Land sighted on starboard
quarter at 4.15 P.M. Aquitania
left rest of convoy behind
& speeded up. Passed a
mine-sweeper at 4.5 P.M.
Arrived Fremantle at 6 P.M.
Low lying town, breakwater
harbour, oil tanks.

Pretty sight at night. No black-
-out, city a blaze of lights.
Water-tanker, official
launch party, lighters etc.
came out.

Went to pictures with Bob
& Colin. Up on deck
afterwards. Not feeling too
well. Took 2 aspirins & went
to bed.

Friday 26th. Sept.

Up at 5.15 A.M. Lying about
a mile off Fremantle. Three
other ships of convoy in
harbour. Everyone disappointed
- no shore leave. Fatigues
from 9-10. Sky - blue sky & clouds,
fresh westerly wind. Alarm
signal at 11.15 A.M. Rushed to
boat stations. Reached there
much quicker this time.

In afternoon, drew two sketches
of bed "lay-out" for "B" Company.
After tea, did some washing.
Went to Concert by Northern
Infantry with Bob & Colin.
To bed, 9.30 P.M.
