In late afternoon, two trans-
ports came out of harbour &
anchored near us.

Evening calm. Fremantle
a blaze of lights.

To bed 9.30 P.M.

Sunday 28th. Sept.

Up at 5.15 A.M. Calm morning
- fresh - no wind. On deck
leaning over rail, looking at the
shore. Two other transports still
moored as last evening.

Left Fremantle at 9.30 A.M. Beautiful
morning, sea calm & blue. Bob,
Colin & I went up to Boat Deck
- gorgeous view. Stripped off
& sunbathed. After dinner
got new library book "Old Wine &
New (Deeping)" lay on deck &
read with Colin. Sea deep
blue & lovely. Lockheed-Whitson
bomber flew past ships.

Evening; on deck for an hour with
Bob & Colin. wrote to Edna. Supper
of peaches, pineapple & biscuits.
