

Tuesday, 25th. Nov. 1941.

Up at 6 A.M. On duty from 9.30 till 11.20, escort to 6 Italian prisoners (working party). One asked me how many children he had. Said he had 4. He spoke French as well.

Had hot shower in afternoon. At 5 p.m. went on guard duty outside camp till 7.20 p.m. (Prowling guard.) On again from mid-night till 2 A.M. To bed 2.15. Called out at 2.30 as lights were switched out. On guard till 4 A.M. Back to bed.

Wednesday, 26th. Nov., 1941

Beautiful & sunny. Not on duty. Did some washing in morning.

After dinner, read book & wrote to Edna.

On escort duty from 2.30 till 4 p.m. watching 10 Italians over a tent. Bill Jordan (N.3. High Commissioner) visited the camp. Spoke in French to prisoner called Joseph, 45 years old: has 4 children.
