Egyptian currency is based upon the English pound. One pound Egyptian is worth 20^s / 6^d sterling There are one hundred piastres in an Egyptian pound.

- 1/2 P. T. Ersh - Tarifa, or Tarifa.
- 1 P. T. Ersh - Saagh, or Wahed Saagh
- 2 P. T. Nuss - Franc, Ersheen - Saagh or Arbaa Tarifa
- 5 P. T. Khamsa - saagh, or Wahed Shilling.
- 10 P. T. Ashara - Saagh, Bariza, or Nuss Real
- 20 P. T. Real, or Eshreen - Ersh.
- 50 P. T. Khamseen Ersh, or Nuss - Guine.
- 100 F. T. Wahed - Guine, or Meet - Ersh,
