 Got a haversack, new pair of Hun lace-up boots etc.
 Lots of stuff lying about.
 Moved on after tea to a new area. Slept on top of our truck (Dodge 15 cwt).

7

SAT. Friday

Several hundred Hun & Itie prisoners brought in. (They had fired on our convoy). Our A.Th. & MMGs replied, wounding several. (600 P.M. 100 ft. 90 light)

On we go in pursuit of the fleeing enemy. Our convoy reached right across horizon.
 Stopped for night.
 Gun fire to West.

8

Heavy rain. Ground very soft. Unable to go on.

Good news about progress of battle. 30,000 prisoners. Not many German tanks left.

Had a look at captured German Red Cross Van. Wonderful equipment. Got documents & books. Raining in and off. Slept under Sunday bivvy tent.

Sunday Mon.

9 Nov

Chasing up the enemy. Started off again. Truck got stuck. Pulled out by Bren Carrier.
