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heart of the old city & on rounding a corner came suddenly to an amazing sight - the Wailing Wall with thousands of Jews of both sexes all wailing & chanting just as they have done for centuries. I say again - it was an amazing sight - so unexpected & so real. It gave one a funny feeling not easily described.

There was the wall, some 40 yds. in length & 20 odd feet high, part of the original temple wall - & all along its length, the women separate from the men, were Jews of all ages pressed up against the wall, some chanting from open prayer books, some without. They took no notice of us standing there - or if they did notice us, did not resent our intrusion.

Yes, it was an amazing sight.

We next entered the temple area - an expanse of several acres containing among other buildings the big Moslem mosque of St.
